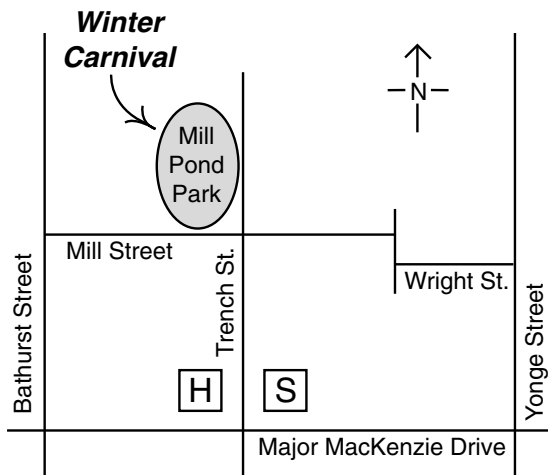
The Winter Carnival Legend
