- North West Corner of Yonge & Carrville Road

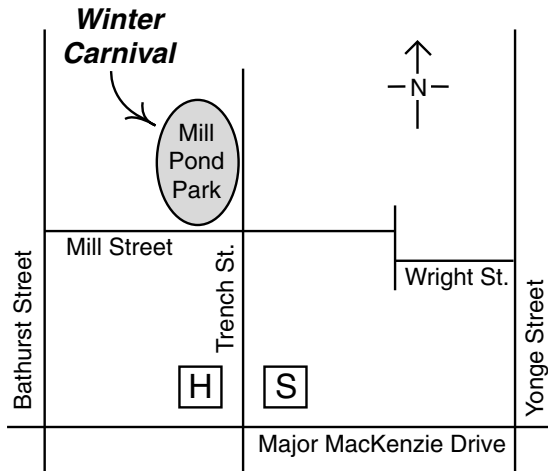
The North Loop:
