



Richmond Hill Winter Carnival 2021

Olaf Snowman Craft



Join us in making an Olaf snowman.

Materials required:

- White paper
- Black construction paper
- Orange construction paper
- toilet tissue tube
- 2 twigs for Olaf's arms
- Tape
- Glue
- Black marker

If you don't have orange or black paper, use white paper and colour it.

Step 1

Attach white paper to the exterior of the paper tube using tape.

Step 2

Using black construction paper, cut three circles one centimetre in diameter. Glue the three black dots in a vertical line. The first one should be located about midway down the tube. Glue the remaining two black circles.

Step 3

Using orange construction paper, cut out a triangle for Olaf's nose. A triangle with a 1.5cm base and 3.5cm tall will work. Bend the bottom of the triangle so you have a tab to glue it with. Centre Olaf's orange nose midway between the top of the tube and the top button.

Step 4

Draw Olaf's eyes, eyebrows, mouth, and tooth using a black marker.



Step 5

Cut three small strips of black construction paper to use for Olaf's hair. Attach them with glue or tape inside the tube.

Step 6

Carefully poke a hole in each side of the tube at a height just above the top bottom. Insert a stick on each side so Olaf has arms.

Step 7

Cut two short strips of white paper about 1.5cm wide. Roll them up to form Olaf's feet and tape the role closed. Attach them to the tube using glue.
